Agenda Item: Welcome and Introductions

- Charlie Vannatta, Committee Chairman, opened the meeting with a safety briefing of the facilities. He then gave a brief summary of the purpose of the committee and asked the attendees to introduce themselves (see the attendance list).
- Rhett Winter emphasized the point to the attendees that the purpose of the meetings is to share best practices and network together for the good of the industry.

Agenda Item: General Discussion, Best Practices & Regulatory Update

- Charlie Vannatta – Opened the floor for general discussion, safety alerts & best practices. Some of the issues discussed were:
 - Rhett Winter spoke about a recent fatality on an Apache location involving a ditch-digging machine.
 - Michael Dodick of Check-6 stated that they had also heard of the fatality and that the committee needs to continue to communicate these incidents as safety alerts and to always be aware of 3rd party on locations.
 - Jimmy Fry of 5J Trucking reminded the committee to be on the lookout for county permit enforcement. It appears to be the next big thing on the regulatory forefront for CMV operators.
 - Charlie Vannatta then mentioned that the state of New Mexico is looking at adopting a permitting system for their country roads.

Charlie Vannatta and Rhett Winter – Charlie and Rhett informed the committee that the Forklift operator document has now been completed and has been posted to the website. The task group's next task will be developing a recommended practices document for rig moving. Initially, the TG had decided to work on a truck pusher competency document, however this changed after a discussion at the meeting. The next meeting date will be January 21st (location TBD). Charlie reminded the group that the templates are completely voluntary.

The competencies can be developed in-house and added to your training program.

The template can be customized to fit your company's needs and operations. Our goal is to stay out in front of OSHA and to assist companies with providing a safe work environment for their employees.
