Agenda Item: Welcome and Introductions

- Charles Vannatta, Committee Chairman, opened the meeting and thanked Moore Truck & Equipment and Fowler Transportation for hosting the meeting and providing lunch. The meeting room safety briefing and other information was given by an employee of the Courtyard Marriott Hotel. Charlie then asked the attendees to introduce themselves (see the attendance list).
- Rhett Winter reminded the attendees, especially the new attendees, that the purpose of the meetings is to share best practices and networking and that the committee works together for the good of the industry. The committee is utilizing subject matter experts to create competency guidelines to assist companies with providing a safe work environment for their employees.

Agenda Item: General Discussion – Safety Minute – Best Practices

- Charlie Vannatta – Opened the floor for general discussion, safety alerts & best practices. Some of the issues discussed were:
 - A member shared an incident in Dimmitt County where a jury awarded 281 million to the family of a man killed when he was struck by a drive shaft that broke off a truck involved in activity in the Eagle Ford Shale.

Agenda Item: Competency Task Group Update

- Charlie Vannatta and Rhett Winter – Charlie and Rhett informed the committee that the Winch/Haul KSA document has been completed and posted to the website. Plus the tandem/bed document is in the final stage of review and will be posted within a two weeks. Also, that there will be a WebEx on March 25th from 1400-1600 that will be the initial meeting for the forklift operator competency document. Charlie reminded the group that the templates are completely voluntary.

The competencies can be developed in-house and added to your training program. The template can be customized to fit your company's needs and operations. Our goal is to stay out in front of OSHA and to assist companies with providing a safe work environment for their employees.
