

1ST QUARTER MEETING FEBRUARY 11-13 2014 HOUSTON, TX

DAY 1 - Tuesday February 11th - 2013

0840 - Welcome, Announcements & Safety Moment

Martin Culen welcomed the UBO-MPD committee, thanked IADC for hosting the meeting and ABS for sponsoring the coffee and lunches.

Scott Maddox (IADC) gave the group a safety orientation and reviewed emergency procedures.

Scott Maddox (IADC) reviewed the IADC Anti-Trust Guidelines and expressed that the guidelines could be retrieved in their entirety from the IADC web site.

Thomas from Siem Wis then presented safety moment "Icy Road Conditions" driver awareness. All should be aware of the changing weather conditions. 4Q13 Meeting Highlights Overviewed

UBO Subcommittee Isabel (Halliburton)

- Status of the 92U document was shared, with information from previous document custodian passed to Isabel. Document is presently with API, however, there are outstanding comments from reviewers that have not been included.
- Committee requested information for subcommittees with regards to air drilling operations in relation to task group discussions.

MPD Subcommittee

- John Kozicz was not present, and Brian Grayson updated group
- 3 documents being worked on
 - 1. PMCD Subsea Stack



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- 2. PMCD/MCD/DMCD Land/Surface Stack
- 3. CBHP Subsea Stack
- MPD document (CBHP Land/Surface Stack) 92M– Final review completed graphical work needs to be done showing barriers
- PMCD onshore document pending
- Questions as to whether documents will be worked on concurrently or sequentially
- Combine surface stacks and offshore in one overall 92M document that covers the different types of MPD discussed.
- API has two standard meetings discussing technical issues
- Subsea stack work still pending with the completion of one additional chapter ()
 - consider reassigning PMCD surface stack discussions
- Presentations being worked on for the DGD workshop in Madrid

DGD Subcommittee

Frederic Jaquemin provided an update via email as he was unable to attend the first day of meeting, with the emphasis being on the upcoming DGD workshop in Madrid. All planning is on track for the workshop, and no break out groups are anticipated for this week's meeting.

Certification Task Group

CJ Bernard updated the Committee on the status of the group and work done.

- If anyone would like to form part of the group please communicate to CJ
- Suggestions have been made to DNV to have more input from the industry technical experts in relation to MPD
- DNV recognizes that the document requires review
- Next review planned in March/14
- Work required during these meetings on document review, feedback to DNV
- Steps required to communicate to DNV the forward plan to capture all requirements and recommended practices
- Jeff Robbie commented that MPO may be able to give advice as per working with DNV

HSE / Training Subcommittee

CJ Bernard updated the committee with regards to the work performed after the last meeting. The current document was reviewed in the intervening months and suggestions made by Adrian Holbrook for enhancements.

- An open discussion began with regards to the need to significantly alter the current document. CJ will discuss the way forward with those committee members who would like to help finalize the document.
- Martin Culen updated the group on the UBO training initiative and the work that IADC requires to finalize the changes to the curriculum.

Outreach Subcommittee

There was no interim work performed by the subcommittee, but a discussion ensued on the perpetual topic of how to engage more operators in the Committee.



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Brian Grayson commented as to possibility of arranging a booth to be manned during next DGD/MPD conference, dependent on space availability.

- George Medley still identified as point of contact
- Martin Culen with follow-up with George M. and BSEE to re-establish link for future communication

1050 - Status of API 16RCD

Martin provided an update on the Task Groups work.

- First Edition reaffirmed Q4 2013
- Best practices /operational testing is the further work required by the group.
- Second edition (e2) of the document cleaned up however API has gueries from the technical writer
- In addition comments have been made for further testing requirements/JIP
- Task Group members have received working documents, and made final comments to some of the proposed changes to e2. These will be finalized during the week.

1100 - Well Control Committee Liaison

Earl D attended the WC committee meeting and provided the following update via email:

- They are creating new documentation for new well control training (WCI)
- Looking at curriculum, Electronic testing ideas, instructor certification, train the trainer, and standard
- Simulation subcommittee are working on how simulators are used in training and competency (No update)
- API outreach RP53 needs to be read by all, as it is being moved from offshore to onshore by regulators
- Asked for a 2014 Well Control Committee vice chair (Drilling Contractor only), no volunteers
- Gas in Riser workshop is coming up (Paul Sonnerman w/Safekick is chairman)
- Deepwater well control subcommittee is almost done with IADC RP
- API meetings June 16 in Chicago coming up

A discussion amongst the committee centered round the linkage between Riser Gas Handling and MPD, and whether or not these too should be combined or mutually exclusive. The Committee remained divided on the subject with further discussion with the Well Control Committee required.

MPD Best Practices

- Break out session will be conducted (Per Cato / Sara)
- Motion raised by Sara and seconded by Mike V to have one amended MPD best practices document (Committee voted unanimously)
- PMCD Surface Stack RP is currently stalled. Sara and Dennis will contact Bob to discuss the document forward plan.

- API 16RCD – (Martin Culen / Sara)

- Sara brought to the group's attention that future work on operational testing of RCDs would best be suited in a specification or a standard and not an RP, as it was felt that RPs do not carry sufficient weight. She suggested different testing classes be added to API Spec 16 RCD, where the current testing would be the base case.
- The Task Group will discuss and revert back to committee on how to integrate the new testing procedures.

1150 Discussion of New Business

Continuous Circulation Subs – The initiative to develop a manufacturing standard for circulation subs was
discussed within the Committee. Brian G commented based on history, API do not generally consider
requirements for standards if not in common use by multiple providers. This is based upon experience
with downhole isolation valves. It was determined by the committee that this issue could be parked.
