- Guest Speaker – Warwick Williams (Department of Transport and Main Roads)** provided a presentation on access for heavy vehicles. Warwick provided a lot of information about the current state of DMR with respect to the issues with moving heavy vehicles, including transporting new equipment from in and out of the Port of Brisbane. The Department is working in collaboration with the IADC-AC Rig Move/Logistics sub-committee and are using Savanna Rigs for the development of the new online permitting system.

- **Guest Speaker – Daryl Brooker (DNRM)** provided a presentation on the upstream and petroleum & inspectorate Drilling and Workover update. Daryl provided information regarding the current improvements and changes the Inspectorate is working on, in particular the new guidelines and standards, as well as the current plan for auditing. The focus will be around SMP's and in particular licence holders' responsibilities. The Inspectorate is developing checklists for self auditing.. These will be distributed prior to the audits being conducted. The current Inspection program will cover 5 main areas: Electrical; Iron Roughneck; Hazardous area; Commissioning and Competencies.
