# MINUTES OF IADC-BRAZIL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING – BUDGET MEETING HELD ON MAY 18<sup>th</sup> 2015 4:00pm TO 6:00pm AT ODEBRECHT'S OFFICE IN MACAE

## Present at this meeting were the following:

## The topics of discussion for this meeting were as follows:

- o Chapter Fees for 2016
- o IADC-BRAZIL Chapter account balance
- o IADC-BRAZIL current year financial expenses
- Cook Off
- Christmas Party
- o May 28<sup>th</sup> GM

#### The following items were agreed upon

- It was suggested that the IADC- BRAZIL CHAPTER funds the expenses to send Gioppo to Houston to the IADC annual meeting. A budget amount needs to be calculated and viability needs to be assessed
- The expenses were discussed and were agreed to be in line with the expected amount.
- There was a possibility of having a GM in June, however with the Brasil Offshore it
  is uncertain if the meeting would attract more people or not. Therefore, the
  decision taken was that June is already a busy month and that the committee
  should do less and do it better. Then, June GM was not agreed to.
- The current fee for membership is R\$4500 for DC, R\$2900 for associate members (more than 50 employees) and R\$1500 (less than 50 employees). The membership for 2016 was agreed to increase 15%.
- The Cook Off event will be postponed. The new date was agreed to July the 25<sup>th</sup>.

### The following items were discussed yet they remain open

- A strategic program will be written for 2016 to improve membership advantages.
  The following topics were considered; having an administrator working fulltime,
  including a communication package, contract BGI. This strategic program will be
  discussed further in future meetings.
- Non-member companies that want to present at the GM will be charged as a sponsor of the event with R\$1000. It was suggested to increase to R\$2000. However, this topic remains open.
- IADC's GM on the 28<sup>th</sup> is confirmed to be in Rio. However, depending on how many people are going to attend the meeting the venue may be changed for a smaller one.

#### **Actions**

- Marcelo to check if it is possible to have free Doc (transference in between different banks) considering how much IADC has in the bank.
- Barrie to inform Cook Off teams and sponsors about the new date for the event.
- Thaisa to contact Four Points Sheraton and Royal Hotel to ask for availability on Dec 5<sup>th</sup> for the IADC Christmas Party as well as to get their cost breakdowns for the event.
- IADC will try to get a 30 min time slot in every Petrobras RAC meeting and look for reaching Petrobras people. Martin and Bruno to action with Joao Cabral.
