- Application fees: Payment of fees should be made at time of application. All applications are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (DIT-01). All application fees are non-refundable, even in the event the accreditation is denied or cancelled.
- Modifications: A fee will be charged for modifications made to an already accredited course that requires technical review unless it is made during the renewal period.
- Audit Fees & Expenses: Audit costs are dependent upon the number of courses to be audited and provider location. Costs include: auditor's day rate fee, travel expenses, and an administrative fee. A multi-day audit may be required. An initial deposit will be required.
- Provider accounts not in good standing will result in revocation of Accreditation. For more information, please refer to the Accreditation Procedures section of the Handbook for Accreditation.
