  applications are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (GTW-01).
- Certificates are available only to accredited providers that have been approved by IADC and to trainees who
  have successfully completed the program. Records of certificates issued to trainees must be reported to IADC
  within 30 days of training completion.
- Additional fees will be required for site visits/audits. Site visit/audit fees include auditor(s) fee(s) that is based on length of audit and day rate for the auditor(s), travel expenses incurred (if applicable) that are based on actual costs of relevant travel and accommodation expenses, and an administration fee.
- Fees in arrears may result in revocation of accreditation. For more information, please refer to section four (4) of the Handbook for Accreditation.
