- Application fees: Payment of fees should be made at time of application. All applications are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (HUE-01). All application fees are non-refundable, even in the event the accreditation is denied or cancelled.
- Modifications: A fee will be charged for modifications made to an already accredited course that requires technical review unless it is made during the renewal period.
- Audit Fees & Expenses: Expenses associated with the conduct of each *WellSharp* audit are to be reimbursed by the accredited training provider. Costs include: auditor's day rate fee, travel expenses, and an administrative fee. A multi-day audit may be required. An initial deposit will be required.
