815 - 900	<p>Open Discussion: Committee Leadership Update, Safety Issues, Regulatory Notices Eamonn Young & Thad Dunham</p> <p><i>The following topics were discussed:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The pros/cons of moving rigs at night and is it ultimately safe? The road and DOT regs are a major concern. Additionally, the body clock or circadian rhythm becomes a factor -The majority of the weight falls between the contractors and the rig movers, the operators aren't as affected if there's an incident on a rig move -The ISP Annual Report shows that for U.S. Land, the majority of recordable incidents happen during rig moves. -The competency documents that were developed by the rig moving committee were also viewed as a reminder to the committee -There was discussion on the industry lacking a best practices document for rig moving and if night moves and well servicing should be included? -There was an action item to form a subcommittee to address 24 hour rig moves...to define exactly what constitutes a 24 hour move and address benefits/risks/hazards/processes...and break down what the actual operations entail. This group will meet the day before the next committee meeting. -There was also a discussion of a contractor having no incidents on night moves in the middle east and south American primarily due to the culture -consensus was that this is the ideal group to set an industry standard
