## Minutes

**Call to Order:** The Chairman (Jorge Lebrija) welcomed everyone in attendance to the Supply Chain Meeting.

### **Safety Briefing/ Anti – Trust Guidelines/Administration**

John Pertgen (IADC liaison) provided the emergency response information including muster points. He also reviewed the Anti-Trust Guidelines; wherein he emphasized the core of anti-trust law, and the required refrain from discussing pricing, dividing, allocating or boycotting suppliers or potential suppliers.

### **General Introductions & Agenda Review**

Formal introductions were conducted. The agenda for the meeting was shared by the Chairman.

### **MRB Documentation Sub-Committee Update**

- Sub Committee Chairman (Brad Green) provided an update on the subcommittee progress
- ITP section expected to be completed in next subcommittee meeting.
- Subcommittee will then expand other sections of the MRB Guidance document
- NOV has agreed to provide an example of updated MRB as per IADC recommendation
- Chairman invited drillers to actively participate in this subcommittee and to include their quality departments.
- It is important for drillers to mention the IADC MRB standard in the applicable purchase orders.

### **Inventory Sub-Committee Update**

- Sub Committee Chairman (Andy Rennie) provided an update on the subcommittee progress
- Excess inventory exchange is working for some drillers. There is a standard agreement template in place for sharing excess inventory.
- Subcommittee will focus on management of rubber goods and preservation of equipment
- Chairman invited drillers to actively participate in the subcommittee.

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## Vendor Performance Sub-Committee Update

- Sub Committee Vice chairman (Stephen Elliot ) provided an update on the subcommittee progress
- Vice chairman shared the mission statement and strategy developed during the first subcommittee working session
- Subcommittee will focus on developing additional quality and reliability SMART metrics by end of Q3-2017

- Vice Chairman (Abhishek Vyas) discussed the following:
- 1. Proposal to have guest speakers in the quarterly meetings. Proposal was accepted by the committee. Vice Chairman and Chairman will explore options to invite a speakers for quarterly meetings
- 2. Proposal to start the Dubai IADC Supply Chain Committee. Proposal was well received by the committee. Chairman will work with IADC to receive guidelines and contact IADC Dubai office. An invitation will be sent for participants to share with their Dubai offices.
- 3. Participation of other companies (non-drillers) in the Supply Chain Committee. It was agreed to keep the Committee open for drillers only. Other companies such as operators, oilfield service providers or manufacturers can be invited to participate in particular subcommittee initiatives.
