IADC-Australasia Chapter Safety Statistics Award 2013

AGM Perth, Australia - 08 April 2014

Following the IADC-AC decision to reinvigorate the ***Safety Statistics Award Program***, after a 3 year hiatus, the Award Program was put back in place for 2013. The Award program is open to all Onshore and Offshore members with a winner designated for each area. 13 of the 16 IADC Australasia chapter member companies participated, resulting in an uptake rate of 81.25% which was great effort, and we would like to thank all of the members who participated. The safety statistics for the participating companies were supplied quarterly by completing the contractor template and followed the **IAW 2013-ISP IADC Official Rules and Guidelines**. An independent company was contracted to collate and provide the final results, which advised the final statistics and best performers.

Some of the combined onshore and offshore key statistics were:

12,445,913.16 man hours of operation; 33 Medical Treatment cases; 18 Lost Time Incidents; 35 Restricted Work/Transfer Cases. LTIFR = 1.45; DARTFR = 4.26 and TRIFR = 6.91; 0 Fatalities.
