Minutes

Call to Order: The Chairman (Mike Curtis) welcomed everyone in attendance to the Supply Chain Meeting.

Safety Briefing/ Anti – Trust Guidelines/Administration

Mike Curtis provided the emergency response information, including muster points. He also reviewed the Anti-Trust Guidelines; wherein he emphasized the core of anti-trust law, and the required refrain from discussing pricing, dividing, allocating, or boycotting suppliers or potential suppliers.

General Introductions & Agenda Review

Attendees introduced themselves. The agenda for the meeting was shared by the Chairman.

Supplier Performance Sub-Committee Update

- Stephen Elliot led a discussion to update attendees on sub-committee progress
- Everyone ratified the new proposed subcommittee mission statement.
- The Committee held a discussion around what messages should be sent to suppliers by this sub-committee. Agreed that the Committee will send a message to suppliers to focus on on-time delivery (OTD).
- Agreed that suppliers should measure their performance based on IADC's metrics
- Agreed that the Sub-Committee will bring in 3-5 OEMs to start the discussion – potentially NOV, GE, Cameron, and MH Wirth
- The Sub-Committee will ask suppliers what they think their target OTD performance should be, and will baseline targets off of those figures.

Inventory Sub-Committee Update

- Andy Rennie led a discussion to update attendees on sub-committee progress
- Southeast Asia participants have been showing increased interest, with a number of companies interested
- Elastomers management initiative

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- Reviewed late Q4 and January Sub-Committee meetings
- Discussed options for best path forward for Sub-Committee – may ask that OEMs publish their standards for proper storage of rubber goods and allow drillers to extend expirations provided these standards are adhered to

Southeast Asia Chapter Update

- Mike Curtis reviewed the minutes of the recent Southeast Asia meeting

Brainstorming Session

- A brainstorming session was led by Mike Curtis to generate ideas for the Committee to pursue in 2019. Some of the ideas discussed:
 - Logistics & trade compliance – more involvement with Jones Act regulatory discussions
 - Increase publicity of what the Committee is doing – e.g. publish in IADC magazine, showcase successes in IADC emails
 - Proposal to split the Inventory Sub-Committee into two – one focused on elastomers, the second focused on inventory sharing
 - Inventory sharing / database
 - Find a way to get OEM data into the database, e.g. surplus assets and equipment to consolidate this information into once place
 - Potential to open the database up to brokers; however there was reluctance to publicize the database to that extent
- The Committee made a decision to add another Vice-Chairman to the Inventory Sub-Committee to help push it forward
