

HEALTH SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE FIRST QUARTER GENERAL MEETING

Agenda Item: Opening:

John Karish, Ensco International HSE Manager and Committee Chairman opened the meeting welcoming everyone to the committee meeting and the HSE – T Conference. Joe Hurt provided safety briefing and general building information. Due to the large number of attendees introductions were forgone.

Agenda Item: Regulatory Issues

Alan Spackman, IADC Vice President Regulatory Affairs discussed the formation of an IADC Interest Group to potentially provide input to EPA Region 4 regarding air permitting for rigs conducting OCS operations in the Eastern GoM, east of 87.5W Longitude. EPA R4 has established a working group on air permitting issues. The group is likely to consider a variety of issues, some of which may benefit from the direct participation of drilling contractors, including the potential streamlining of permits, and best available control technology determinations for marine engines installed on MODUs. He also indicated that the International Association of Oil and Gas Producers (OGP) and the International Petroleum Industry Environmental Conservation Association (IPIECA) were developing Voluntary Sustainability Reporting guidance. As its provisions could influence future contract provisions, IADC had distributed copies for comment IADC with the view that IADC would provide comments on the guidance.

Joe Hurt, IADC Regional VP North America and HSE Affairs, reported on recent issues that have to the attention of IADC. Nevada recently passed requirements for all construction workers to receive the OSHA 10 hour course for Construction. Some members had been informed that they needed to train their personnel per this new rule. IADC found that drilling personnel do not need this training. OSHA is planning to rewrite regulations regarding "Walking & Working Surfaces", "Fall Protection", and "Electrical Safety". JH also reported that the IADC Rig Moving Committee has completed the Gin Pole Truck Guidelines and they will be issued on March 1, 2010.

Agenda Item: Life Boat Issue:

Bob Kahak, Manager Engineering Products, Alexander Ryan Marine & Safety Co. discussed safety of life boats when lowering and training them. Bob also showed a DVD on a new product that ARMS has developed to prevent the inadvertent release of the life boat during drills. During the discussion Bob emphasized that adequate training to personnel who are responsible for operating life boats is the best solution to the dropped life boat issue.
