REVISED SUPERVISORY DRILLING CURRICULUM

The WellCAP Supervisory Level Drilling Curriculum Guidelines (Form WCT-2DS) have been revised to reflect changes recently made by the IADC Well Control Committee.

The revision consists of adding a subheading B in the Training Topics column in Section IX, titled "Bridging Documents," with a corresponding item in the "Job Skills" column reading "Describe how bridging documents can resolve differences between operator and contractor well control policies (e.g., shallow gas and diverter operations)."

This change was made in Revision 050105 on page 38 of Form WCT-2DS, shown on the following page. The change was also incorporated into Revision 050105 of the Supervisory Level Cross-Reference Tool, Form WCT-2DS-X. Both forms are available from the WellCAP online documents section of the IADC web site.

In accordance with WellCAP Procedures, all WellCAP schools are required to implement this change in their supervisory drilling level instruction by 1 June 2005.

This bulletin supercedes all versions of WCT-1 dated prior to November 2004. For more information, contact IADC.
