IADC/IWCF ALLIANCE REVISED DRILLING CURRICULUM GUIDELINES

As first announced in Bulletin 97-02, IADC has entered into a joint effort with the International Well Control Forum (IWCF) known as the International Alliance for Well Control (IAWC). The alliance will allow a qualified school to issue successful students a certificate jointly endorsed by IADC and IWCF.

That agreement has brought numerous changes to the WellCAP drilling curriculum which have been incorporated into the enclosed Form WCT-2D, Revision 970811.

In order to help identify which items have been changed, enclosed is a companion document. All items in the latest revision of WCT-2D that have been changed from the earlier version are underlined in the companion document.

In accordance with WellCAP procedures in *The Handbook for Accreditation*, all currently accredited WellCAP schools or schools which are seeking accreditation have six months from receipt of this document to incorporate the relevant changed items into their lesson plans, manuals, handouts, tests and other instructional items.
