This bulletin is issued to all schools that are accredited or are now in the process of completing an Application for Accreditation.

REVISED CURRICULUM GUIDELINES

IADC has redesigned curriculum guidelines for both drilling and workover/completion instruction provided under the Well Control Accreditation Program (WellCAP).

Guidelines for different levels of instruction (introductory, fundamental, and supervisory) have been separated into individual documents for easier reference. All curriculum guidelines have also been reformatted so topics of instruction appear side-by-side with the relevant job skills.

The instructional requirements are essentially unchanged. The purpose of these revisions is to eliminate confusion reported by some schools when trying to reference the curriculum.

Previously, all levels of Drilling instruction had been contained in form WCT-2D, and all levels of Workover/Completion in form WCT-2D.

WellCAP forms have been renumbered as follows:

Drilling	Workover/Completion
WCT-2DI Introductory Level	WCT-2WI Introductory Level
WCT-2DF Fundamental Level	WCT-2WF Fundamental Level
WCT-2DS Supervisory Level	WCT-2WS Supervisory Level

The new forms are being distributed with this bulletin to all accredited schools and schools with accreditation pending. Copies are available on request from IADC. The forms will also be archived in PDF format on the IADC web site.

The Handbook for Accreditation, form WCT-1, is currently under revision and will be issued shortly with Bulletin 99-02.
